



Is there really a need for a Metropolitan Park District to support the Friends Of The Pool's over \$20 million dollar Methow Aquatics Complex???

Do you really want your property taxes and rents to go significantly up???

Proposition 1 is not about simply replacing a community pool. It is about creating a powerful Metropolitan Park District permanent taxing authority called the Aquatics District with an unelected governing Board requiring no input from the taxpayers. Proposition 1 empowers the Board to levy up to \$67 million in debt and \$2 million in annual taxes.

Proposition 1 proponents advocate a \$25+ million indoor aquatic center costing \$1 million per year to operate. No comparable rural community in the country has such an indoor aquatic center.

Proposition 1 will divert community resources to a swimming facility benefiting a few at the expense of real community priorities like schools, affordable housing and health care.
